Those of you who have taken advantage of our Lakewood Ski Trails have noticed that we have been working on cleaning up some of the tree damage that occurred last fall in the windstorms. As soon as the snow recedes some, we will start to remove the trees between the sand traps and cart path on Number 13. Removing these trees will improve the microclimate in this area by increasing the airflow to both the 13th and 15th greens, also allowing more sunlight on the 13th. We plan to use the wood chips from this renovation on our cart paths, helping us decrease our carbon footprint and keeping costs down for all of you.
